

ORDINANCE NO 102

AN ORDINANCE INCORPORATION CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE  
INTOXICATING LIQUOR ACT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA  
BY REFERENCE, AND REPEALING THOSE ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT  
OR CONFLICTING WITH SAID ACT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOKAH, HOUSTON, COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA, ORDAINS AD FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

Chapter 340, Minnesota general statues, as amended is hereby adopted as the intoxicating liquor and non-intoxicating malt liquor ordinance regulating the use, possession, and sale of intoxicating liquors and non-intoxicating malt liquors in the City of Hokah, Minnesota, and are hereby incorporated in and made a part of this ordinance as fully and completely as if the same were set out hereat in full.

SECTION II. REPEAL

All provisions of ordinances of the City of Hokah which are inconsistent with the provisions of the said Chapter 340, are hereby repealed and declared null and void.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption and its publication as provided by law.
