

ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PUBLIC CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF IN THE CITY OF HOKAH, HOUSTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The city council of the City of Hokah, Houston County, Minnesota, hereby ordains the following:

SECTION I. It is hereby prohibited to consume alcoholic beverages on the public streets, sidewalks, and parking lots in the City of Hokah.

SECTION II. For purposes of this Ordinance, alcoholic beverages shall be construed to include not only intoxicating alcoholic beverages as defined by the laws of the State of Minnesota, but non-intoxicating malt beverages as well, including malt beverages containing not more than 3.2% alcohol by volume.

SECTION III. Persons convicted of violations of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a petty misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and adoption and publication as provided by law.
