

ORDINANCE NO 20: An Ordinance to prevent the firing of guns, pistols and firecrackers.

The President and Trustees of the Village of Hokah do ordain as follows

SECTION 1.

Any person who shall without the written permission of the President of Said board of Trustees fire off any gun, pistol, firecracker, firearms, or torpedo, or other combustible projectile within the Village limits of Said Village of Hokah shall be fined for each and every offence in a sum not less than five (5) dollars nor more than twenty five (25) dollars and in default of the payment of Said fine may be committed to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty (30) days.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force ten days after being duly posted.
