## ORDINANCE NO 67

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC ALLEYS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HOKAH, MINNESOTA, INCORPATING CERTAIN PROFISIONS OF THE HIGHWAY TRAFFICE REGULATION ACT OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA BY REFERENCE, AND IMPOSING PENATLY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Village Council of the Village of Hokah, Houston County, Minnesota ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. INCORPATION BY REFERENCE OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT. The regulatory provisions of Chapter 169, Minnesota General Statutes 1965 as amended by Laws of Minnesota for 1967, Except Sections 169.10, 169.11, 169.751, 169.752, 169.753, 169.754, 169.965, 169.966, 169.971, 169.972, and 169.973, and Sections 169.991 through 169.998 thereof, are hereby adopted as a traffic ordinance regulating the use of highways, streets and alleys within the Village of Hokah, Minnesota and are hereby incorporated in and made part of this ordinance as fully and completely as if the same were set out hereat in full.

Section 11. PENALTY. Any violation the Statutes adopted by reference in Section 1, is a violation of this ordinance when it occurs within the Village of Hokah. Any person thus violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not to exceed 90 days; but if a minimum fine or imprisonment is prescribed by the State highway Traffic Act for an offense, such penalty shall apply to a person convicted of the same offense under this ordinance.

Section 111. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption and its publication as provided by law.
