

ORDINANCE NO 115-1

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 115, BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE HOURS AND AYS OF SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES INCORPORATING THE LAWS OF THE SATE OF MINNESOTA THEREUNTO APPERTAINING; PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSING OF ESTABLISHMENT SELLING SUCH, AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Hokah hereby ordains:

SECTION I. Except as hereinafter amended the provisions of ordinance no. 115 are hereby reaffirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION II. Consistent with legislative enactment, the 2003 Minnesota Legislative Session, the sale of alcoholic beverages on liquor licensed premises and by 3.2 percent beer licensees, shall be authorized in properly licensed establishments in the City of Hokah between the ours of 2:00 a.m. and 8.a.m. on all days of the week effective upon the due passage and enactment of this ordinance.

SECTION III. Licensees shall make the necessary application for the special 2:00 a.m. license mandated by the Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement Division (AGED) and shall pay the requisite fee. The effectiveness of this ordinance with respect to individual licensees is contingent upon the AGED application, payment of the prescribed fee and the issuance of the special 2:00 a.m. license from the AGED.

SECTION IV. Upon due application for a special 2:00 a.m. license, the City Clerk shall inform and certify to AGED within 10 days the issuance of all 3.2 percent beer licenses which certification is necessary whether or not the licensee is applying for the 2:00 a.m. special license.

This Ordinance is effective upon its due passage and enactment and publication according to law.
