

ORDINANCE NO 21: An Ordinance to license and regulate auctioneers and peddlers. The President and Trustees of the Village of Hokah do ordain as follows.

SECTION 1.

Every person before making an sales as auctioneer or peddler within the corporate limits of the Village of Hokah shall procure from the president of Board of Trustees of Said Village of Hokah a license as here-in-after stated.

SECTION 2.

Every such person desiring to sell as auctioneer or peddler shall apply to the President of the Board of Trustees for a license and before the same shall be granted he shall pay to the President of the Village the following amounts. If for an auctioneers license the sum of two (2) dollars per day. If for a peddlers license with wagon and two or more horses the sum of two (2) dollars per day. If for a peddlers license with wagon and two or more horses the sum of two (2) dollars per day for each day that he may sell at retail. If for a peddlers license with wagon and one horse the sum of two (2) dollars per day for each day he may sell at retail. If for peddlers license on foot the sum of one(1) dollars per day.

SECTION 3.

Every person who shall engage in the sale of goods, wares, or merchandise at auction or by peddling without procuring a license as herein before required shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine or not less than five (5) dollars. And in default of the payment thereof may be imprisoned for a period not exceeding twenty five (25) days.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force ten days after being duly posted.
